A brief note on our institute


The Technical Training Institute – Rangjung (TTI-R) was established by the erstwhile National Technical Training Authority (NTTA) as an extension of the then Royal Technical Institute to provide access to Technical and Vocational Education and Training for the school leavers.

TTI-Rangjung was established through the joint funding of the Asian Development Bank and the Royal Government of Bhutan under the Basic Skills Development Project in 2003.

After its establishment, the institute has until date trained 2276 (1484 M + 792 F) numbers of youth in various trades such as Electrical, Computer Hardware & Networking, Automobile and Furniture Making.

As part of our ongoing efforts to improve the living conditions and ensure the well-being, new water filtration systems were installed in the hostel facilities to provide cleaner and safer drinking water
